NOTICE OF INTENT TO RENEW

This Notice of Intent to Renew ("Notice") effective June 30, 2011 between the City of Glendale, an Arizona municipal corporation ("Glendale") and the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County ("Superior Court").

RECITALS

- A. On April 25, 2006, the parties entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement for Jury Services ("IGA").
- B. The initial term of the IGA was from July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2010, with five one-year renewals.
- C. The parties exercised a renewal option from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011.
- D. The parties desire to exercise the renewal option contained in Paragraph 7 of the IGA.

AGREEMENT

- 1. **Term of IGA.** The term of the IGA is hereby extended from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012.
- 2. **Remaining Provisions.** The remaining provisions of the IGA remain the same.


