

AMENDMENT NO. 5

CODIFICATION OF CITY CODES AGREEMENT
RFQ 10-32 CONTRACT No. C-7250

This Amendment No. 5 to Codification of City Codes Agreement is made effective on the 19 day of February, 2015 ("Effective Date"), by and between the City of Glendale, an Arizona municipal corporation ("City") and Municipal Code Corporation, a Florida corporation authorized to do business in Arizona ("Contractor").

RECITALS


- A. City and Contractor previously entered into an Codification of City Codes, Agreement No. C-7250, dated May 1, 2010 ("Agreement"); and
- B. The Agreement had an initial one-year term beginning May 1, 2010 through April 30, 2011 and provided the option to extend the term for an additional five (5) years in one-year increments; and
- C. City and Contractor previously entered into Amendment No. 1, amending compensation and extending the term of the Agreement from May 1, 2011 through April 30, 2012; and
- D. City and Contractor previously entered into Amendment No. 2, extending the term of the Agreement from May 1, 2012 through April 30, 2013; and
- E. City and Contractor previously entered into Amendment No. 3, extending the term of the Agreement from May 1, 2013 through April 30, 2014; and
- F. City and Contractor previously entered into Amendment No. 4, amending compensation and extending the term of the Agreement from May 1, 2014 through April 30, 2015; and
- G. City and Contractor wish to modify and amend the Agreement subject to and strictly in accordance with the terms of this Amendment.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City and Contractor hereby agree as follows:

1. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are not merely recitals, but form an integral part of this Amendment.
2. **Term.** The term of the Agreement is extended for a final year period from May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2016, unless otherwise terminated or canceled as provided by the Agreement.
3. **Compensation.** The compensation as set forth in Exhibit B-Amendment No. 4, remains unchanged.
4. **Insurance Certificate.** The existing insurance certificate is expiring and a new certificate applying to the extended term is required and must be received by the Contract Specialist prior to May 1, 2015.
5. **Ratification of Agreement.** City and Contractor hereby agree that except as expressly provided herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall be, and remain in full force and effect and that if any provision of this Amendment conflicts with the Agreement, then the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.




