COUNCILMEMBER RAY MALNAR HIGHLIGHTS IMPORTANCE OF CITY CODE COMPLIANCE ON “GLENDALE TODAY”

Glendale, Ariz.---Councilmember Ray Malnar (Sahuaro District) talks with officials from the city’s Code Compliance Division in the latest edition of “Glendale Today,” slated to begin airing Friday, June 16, at 8 p.m., on Glendale 11 TV.

During the show, Malnar offers viewers a new perspective on the importance of complying with city codes and talks about the most common types of code violations.

“It all comes down to being a good neighbor,” said Malnar. “City codes are established community standards that maintain and promote the overall health, safety and living environment of our neighborhoods and community.”
