MEMORIAL DAY HOLIDAY NOTICE

City Office Hours and Schedule Changes

GLENDALE, Ariz. -- City of Glendale offices will be closed on Monday, May 29, in observance of the Memorial Day holiday.

All residential garbage and recycling collection services will take place as usual on all regularly scheduled collection days throughout the holiday week, however the Glendale Municipal Landfill will be closed on May 29 in observance of the holiday. Only Gus Bus One will run on Monday, May 29, operating on the Gus Bus One "Sunday schedule," between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Reservations for Dial-a-Ride service for the weekend preceding the holiday and the observed federal holiday (Monday, May 29) must be made ahead of time – by noon on Friday, May 26. Reservations can be made by calling Glendale's Transit Services at 623-930-3500. No same-day service on Monday will be available. ADA service will be available and will be based on a holiday fixed route schedule. Valley Metro bus and rail will operate Sunday schedules. The Glendale Municipal Airport will remain open during the holiday; however, the airport's administrative offices and Glendale's three public libraries will be closed Monday, May 29, along with the Visit Glendale offices.
