### Glendale Police Promote A Summer of Safety

In an effort to keep our children safe this summer, the Glendale Police Department would like to inform parents and children about city ordinances that outline curfew for those under the age of 18. Juveniles under the age of 16 have a curfew of 10:00 p.m.-5:00 a.m. Those 16 and older have a curfew of 12:00 a.m. - 5:00 a.m. It is also a violation for a parent or guardian to allow a juvenile to violate the curfews that are in place.
