## Traffic Restrictions/Notices Of City Improvements

**To Begin Monday, January 18:** The Water Services Department will begin making repairs to a water line in the intersection of 67th Avenue and Deer Valley Road. This work is estimated to take about four weeks to complete. Westbound Deer Valley traffic will only be permitted to go through or turn right (north) at the 67th Avenue intersection; and eastbound traffic will not be permitted through the intersection, but will be required to turn right only (south) onto 67th Avenue. North and southbound 67th Avenue traffic will have lane restrictions and be shifted to the west side of the intersection (in the southbound lanes). There will be no lefts permitted at the intersection.

## On-Going Projects

The Water Services Department has begun the **Thunderbird Reservoir Improvements project** which has an anticipated completion date of spring, 2016.

There will be signage and employees along Thunderbird Trail notifying users of any hazards. **The project will have no negative impact on the roads or parking lots near and around Thunderbird Conservation Park.**
