

#### City Of Glendale Announcements

Dear Cholla Residents,

The City Council will conduct a Public Hearing regarding proposed changes to water and wastewater rates at the October 24th Voting Meeting. Following the Public Hearing, the Council will be asked to adopt a resolution adjusting water and wastewater rates for the next two years, effective January 1, 2018 and January 1, 2019, respectively.

An in-depth financial analysis determined that a rate increase is necessary for water and wastewater to continue providing uninterrupted service and pay for the increased cost of raw water and electricity, infrastructure maintenance, 38 capital improvement projects, equipment and regulatory compliance.

Results of the financial analysis were discussed in depth

Results of the financial analysis were discussed in depth with the Citizens Utility Advisory Commission, which recommended two options for rate increases for the Council to consider. Council directed staff to revise the plan with a lower rate increase. At the September 19th Workshop the revised plan was presented and there was a consensus to move forward with the revised plan and lower rate increase.

The anticipated impact of the water and wastewater rate adjustments on an average residential customer using 9700 gallons of water and wastewater would increase monthly by \$3.66 in January 2018 and \$3.93 in January 2019.

The City has a responsibility to provide a reliable source of high quality water, and to effectively treat wastewater. The investment in this infrastructure will provide redundancy where needed, replace aging and outdated equipment and capital improvements that will protect our water supply and delivery, and protect against wastewater facility failures.


