Thank you for your interest in applying for a Sahuaro District – Neighborhood Beautification Grant. Based on public input last year, I had the opportunity to allocate funds toward improvement projects throughout the Sahuaro District. Those projects included:

- two solar speed signs posted on N. 77th Avenue, south of Union Hills Drive
- newly painted ramadas at Acoma Park
- a new drinking fountain at Rose Park
- new picnic tables at Chapparal Park, Desert Valley Park, Gables Park, Meadows Park, and Tierra Buena Park
- new benches at Desert Valley Park, Hidden Meadows Park, and Sunset Vista Park

Due to budget savings within my office this year, I can allocate more funds toward neighborhood improvement projects in our district. To complement our efforts from last year, we have added an opportunity within this grant for landscape rock for residential front yard beautification. This is in addition to the opportunity to recommend a project to improve local City of Glendale parks, medians, right of ways, and other city properties within the Sahuaro District.

I look forward to further beautifying our neighborhoods!

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## **Guidelines**

Residents and organizations or businesses within the Sahuaro District in the City of Glendale, AZ may submit applications for neighborhood beautification projects. The project must be within the City of Glendale's Sahuaro District. Please see the attached map to verify if your project proposal is within the Sahuaro District.

Projects may range between \$100 and \$4500. Project funds will not be issued directly to applicants or grantees. Funding will be allocated to complete eligible projects requested by applicants/grantees utilizing City of Glendale resources and vendors.

## **Residential Improvements**

City of Glendale residents may submit applications for:

Landscape rock to be placed at a home's front yard for neighborhood beautification purposes. The applicant must complete landscape preparation prior to rock being dropped at the property. The property must be within the City of Glendale's Sahuaro District. Maximum project grant will be twenty tons of river rock or crushed granite rock. Eligible projects will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis - based on the date received in the Council office.

**\*This is a great opportunity for residents to upgrade front yards, which can bring the property into compliance with city code.**

## **City Owned Property Improvements**

City of Glendale residents and organizations or businesses with an office in the City of Glendale may submit applications for:

Improvements at City of Glendale parks and other City of Glendale public properties within the Sahuaro District. Examples include replacing, painting, or adding a picnic table at a city park; replacing a water fountain; replacing, painting, or adding decorative signage at a city property; beautifying a City of Glendale median or right of way. Eligible projects will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis - based on the date received in the Council office.

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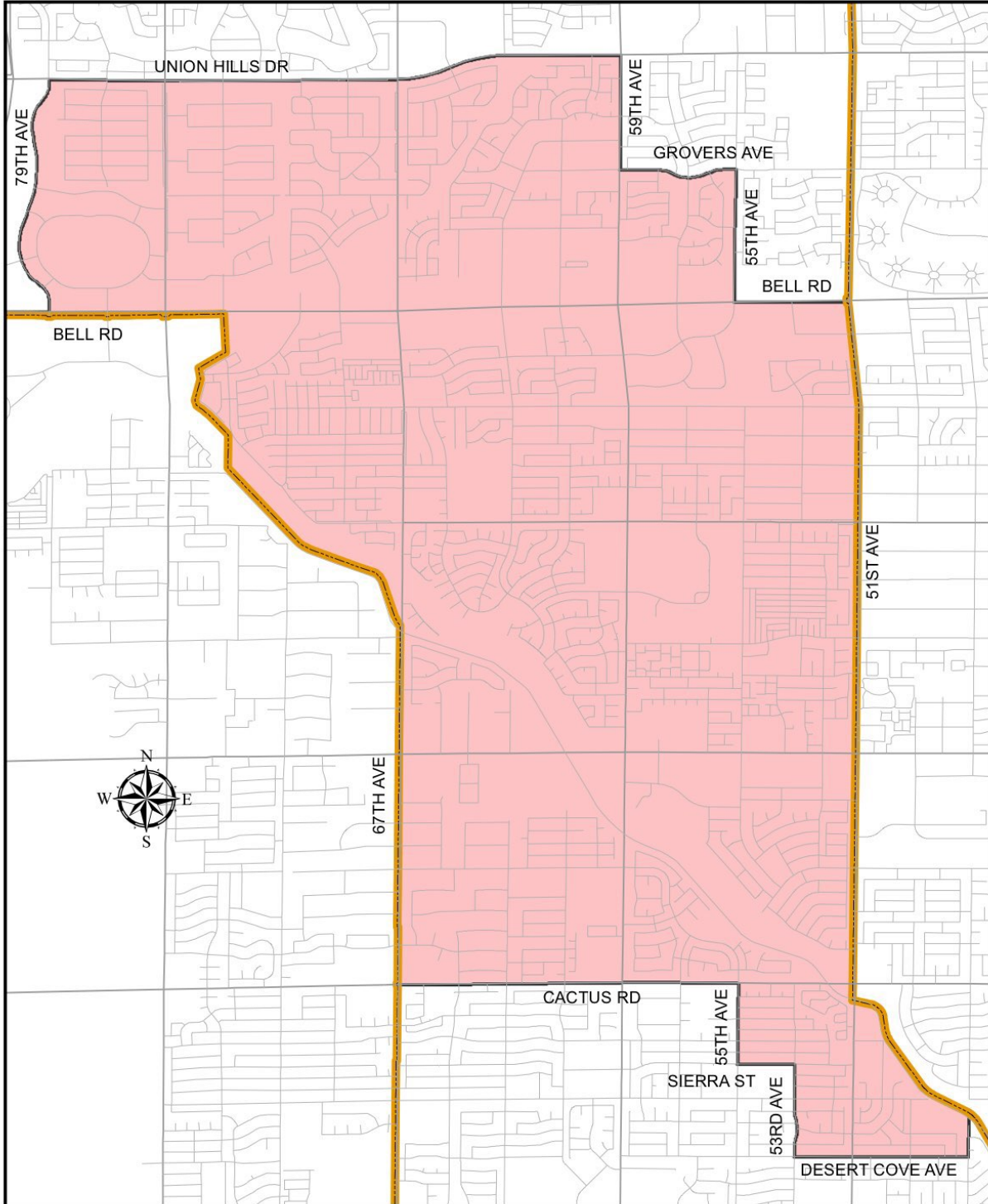
**\*This is a great opportunity for residents and organizations to beautify aspects of neighborhood city parks or other city properties.**

Awarded projects for beautification at an individual resident's front yard for landscaping rock must be accepted via email or U.S. mail to the Council office by applicant within 15 days of grant award notification. If not accepted within 15 days, the application/grant award will be deemed cancelled and the funds will go toward another beautification project.

Eligible projects will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis - based on the date received in the Council office.
