BALLOT ARGUMENTS ACCEPTED FOR UPCOMING ELECTION

Public invited to submit ballot arguments for election publicity pamphlet

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The Glendale City Council has referred five measures to the ballot for the upcoming Nov. 3, 2020, general election and the public is now invited to participate in the process. Interested parties are invited to submit ballot arguments for the election publicity pamphlet, which will be mailed to registered voters ahead of Election Day.

Ballot measures include the approval of a proposed franchise agreement with EPCOR Water Arizona, Inc. and four bond questions to provide funding for landfill facilities improvement projects, parks and recreation projects, streets projects and flood control projects.

Those wishing to file an argument for or against any ballot measure for publication in the election publicity pamphlet may submit a written statement not exceeding 300 words. Arguments must be emailed to the City Clerk's Office no later than 5 p.m. Aug. 5, 2020. Each filed argument requires a payment of \$100.
