HOLIDAY HOURS: THANKSGIVING *City of Glendale Office Hours, Services and Schedule Changes*

GLENDALE, AZ: The city of Glendale offices will be closed on Thursday, Nov. 28 in observance of Thanksgiving, however residents will still be able to access many city services on the holiday and over the long, Turkey Day weekend.

Valley Metro ADA service will be provided on a Sunday schedule on Thanksgiving. Fixed route service will be restricted to the Sunday service levels on Nov. 28. Express and RAPID service will not be available on Nov. 28 and 29. The Glendale Onboard microtransit services will be available on Thanksgiving and Nov. 29. However, all microtransit trips for Nov. 28 and 29 must be scheduled by noon on Nov. 27. ADA services for these routes will be offered on Nov. 28 and 29. On Thanksgiving, only the GUS Bus One will be running and it will be on a Sunday schedule. Then on Nov. 29, GUS One will follow a Saturday schedule. GUS Bus Two and Three will not be in operation on Nov. 28 or 29, though. You can learn more by visiting [Maps & Schedules | Valley Metro](#) or contacting Customer Service at 602-253-5000.

The Glendale Municipal Landfill will be closed on Thanksgiving, but it will reopen with regular business hours on Nov. 29. There will be no residential garbage, recycling and bulk trash collection on Thanksgiving. Then on Nov. 29, residents can expect all residential garbage, recycling and bulk trash collection to be operated but following a Thursday schedule. On Nov. 30, Glendale will provide all residential garbage, recycling and bulk trash collection but as it would with a regular Friday schedule. All services – residential garbage, recycling and bulk trash collection – will resume on a regular schedule on Dec. 2.

All Glendale libraries will be closed on Thanksgiving and Nov. 29. All libraries will reopen on Saturday, Nov. 30, at 10 a.m.

Glendale's recreation centers will be closed on Thanksgiving and Nov. 29. The city's recreational facilities will reopen on Nov. 30, with their regular operational hours, except for the Glendale Adult Center as it is only open Mondays through Fridays. Splash pads in Glendale have already closed for the season, while lap swimming is still available at the Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center for pass-holders and day-pass users.
