HOLIDAY HOURS: PRESIDENTS DAY *City of Glendale Office Hours, Services and Schedule Changes*

GLENDALE, AZ: The city of Glendale offices will be closed on Monday, Feb. 17 in observance of Presidents Day, but residents will still be able to access many services.

Bus and streetcar services will run on a regular schedule on Presidents Day. However, there will be no Express/RAPID bus service on Feb. 17. The Glendale MicroTransit (Dial-A-Ride) office will be closed on the holiday. Passengers who want to take a Dial-A-Ride vehicle on Feb. 17 must make reservations by noon on Feb. 12. ADA service will not be affected by Presidents Day. Glendale Urban Shuttle (GUS) routes 2 and 3 will not be operating on Feb. 17 but GUS route 1 will operate on a regular schedule on the holiday. Residential garbage, recycling and bulk trash collection will take place as usual on a normal schedule on Feb. 17. However, the Glendale Municipal Landfill will be closed to the public on Presidents Day. Glendale's recreation and community centers will be closed on Presidents Day, as will the city's libraries.

Visit Glendale administrative offices and Visitor Center will be closed on Feb. 17.

The Glendale Regional Airport administrative building will be closed on Presidents Day, but the airport itself will be open, as it is 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Its terminal building will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Feb. 17.
