

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD BY THE  
CITY OF GLENDALE ON THE PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT  
TO THE 2018-2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN  
COMMENCEMENT OF THE 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD.**

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Glendale, Arizona proposes to amend its Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19 Year Four Annual Action Plan, under the 2015-2019 Five-Year Consolidated Plan. This Substantial Amendment proposed by the City of Glendale, Community Services Department, Community Revitalization Division, will including the following adjustments to the allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds:

- Reduce the FY 2018-19 CDBG funding allocated to the City of Glendale Parks and Recreation – Park ADA Improvements activity from \$160,000 to \$37,000 (a \$123,000 reduction)
- Reduce the FY 2018-19 CDBG funding for the Residential Rehabilitation Program – City Administered activity from \$886,883 to \$735,120 (a \$151,763 reduction)
- Reduce the FY 2016/17 CDBG funding for the City of Glendale Parks and Recreation – Renovation/Revitalization of Community & Recreation Centers activity from \$117,612 to \$57,612 (a \$60,000 reduction)
- Add an activity called the City of Glendale Parks and Recreation – O’Neil Park activity and increase the CDBG funding from \$-0- to \$334,763. This proposed CDBG physical improvement is an eligible activity under the CDBG National Objectives. This project will result in more recreational opportunity to low to moderate income residents in the proposed project area.

This Substantial Amendment was available for a 30-day public comment period from Thursday, September 27, 2018, to Monday, October 29, 2018, at 5:00 PM. All residents, property owners, persons with disabilities, immigrants, seniors, low-income, children and youth, homeless persons, and other stakeholders of the City of Glendale are encouraged to submit written comments or questions regarding the proposed Substantial Amendment to the FY 2018-19 Annual Action Plan to Charyn Eirich-Palmisano, Community Revitalization Administrator, at Glendale City Hall, 5850 W. A public hearing was originally scheduled by the Community Development Advisory Committee for October 18, 2018, at 6:30 p.m.; however, this meeting had to be delayed and has been

rescheduled for November 15, 2018, in Room B-3, Glendale Municipal Office Complex, 5850 W. Glendale Avenue to allow for public comments/discussion about the proposed Substantial Amendment to the Annual Action Plan. The City Council will be approving the Substantial Amendment at the December 13, 2018 Voting Meeting.

**SUMMARY:**

The City of Glendale's FY 2018-19 Annual Action Plan, the fourth year of the 2015-2019 Five Year Consolidated Plan, requires that this proposed change undergo a Substantial Amendment process. The Substantial Amendment must allow for public participation and a comment period of 30 days. The City of Glendale is proposing to reallocate CDBG physical improvement funds in the amount of \$334,763 to a new eligible CDBG activity, O'Neil Park Redevelopment Project.
