CONSTRUCTION SLATED TO BEGIN THIS MONTH!

Construction plans are now complete and work will soon be underway on the installation of an additional stadium parking area and local roadway and traffic circulation improvements in the vicinity of the Glendale Sports and Entertainment District.

• 95th Avenue Roadway Extension

This project will construct a new five-lane roadway (two travel lanes in each direction with a continuous center left-turn lane) and connect 95th Avenue between Camelback Road and Bethany Home Road.

• New Stadium Parking Lot

The new "Black Lot" parking area at 95th Avenue and Bethany Home Road will provide 4000-plus spaces to accommodate large stadium events. Work will include the installation of storm water detention basins, landscaping, a perimeter screen wall and parking lot lighting.

• Montebello Avenue: 95th Avenue to 91st Avenue

The project will construct a new three-lane roadway (one travel lane in each direction with a continuous center left-turn lane) and connect Montebello Avenue between 95th and 91st Avenues.

The projects are slated for completion in summer 2018.

PEDESTRIAN INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Construction on the pedestrian infrastructure improvements is planned to begin January 2018. Improvements along Bethany Home Road east of 95th Avenue include the installation of a pedestrian underpass and bridged crossings at the Grand Canal and the Bethany Home Outfall Channel, realignment at Bethany Home Road, concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk, landscaping and additional drainage improvements.
