NEW STADIUM PARKING LOT TAKING SHAPE

Construction crews are busy constructing 4,000-plus new parking spaces in the "Black Lot" parking area at 95th Avenue and Bethany Home Road to accommodate large stadium events. Work includes the installation of storm water detention basins, landscaping, a perimeter screen wall and parking lot lighting. The new parking lot is quickly coming together and later this month, paving will begin. Construction of the screen walls continues and landscaping now is underway. Later in April, the contractor will place concrete for the new light pole bases.

PROJECT SCOPE

The City of Glendale's traffic circulation and event parking improvement projects, now underway, will provide additional stadium parking and enhance traffic flow in the vicinity of the Glendale Sports and Entertainment District. The projects are slated for completion in summer 2018.

OTHER PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS

• 95th Avenue Roadway Extension

Construction is planned for a new five-lane roadway (two travel lanes in each direction with a continuous center left-turn lane). It also will connect 95th Avenue between Camelback Road and Bethany Home Road.

• Montebello Avenue: 95th Avenue to 91st Avenue

The project will construct a new three-lane roadway (one travel lane in each direction with a continuous center left-turn lane) and connect Montebello Avenue between 95th and 91st avenues.

• Pedestrian Infrastructure Improvements Project Bethany Home Road, 95th to 91st Avenues

Improvements, which are taking place along Bethany Home Road east of 95th Avenue, began February 1, 2018. Enhancements include the installation of a pedestrian underpass and bridged crossings at the Grand Canal and the Bethany Home Outfall Channel, realignment at Bethany Home Road, concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk, landscaping and additional drainage improvements. **Bethany Home Road between 95th and 91st avenues is closed until July 31, 2018.**
