#### ON THE PROJECT FRONT

City of Glendale traffic circulation and event parking projects will provide additional stadium parking and improve traffic flow in and around the Glendale Sports and Entertainment District. The projects are slated for completion in summer 2018.



#### CONSTRUCTION UNDERWAY

##### • 95th Avenue Roadway Extension

Crews continue installing electrical conduit and are placing concrete curb, gutter, catch basins and valley gutter. The contractor also began grading the roadway in preparation for placing ABC (road base material) later this month.



Improvements include a new five-lane roadway (two travel lanes in each direction with a continuous center left turn lane). The new road will connect 95th Avenue between Camelback Road and Bethany Home Road.

##### • New Stadium Parking Lot

Construction crews have installed the final layer of asphalt and have painted stripes on the parking lot. This month, workers will install the gates and electrical needs for the parking lot lighting.

Plans call for the construction of 4,000-plus new parking spaces, to accommodate stadium events, in the "Black Lot" parking area at 95th Avenue and Bethany Home Road.

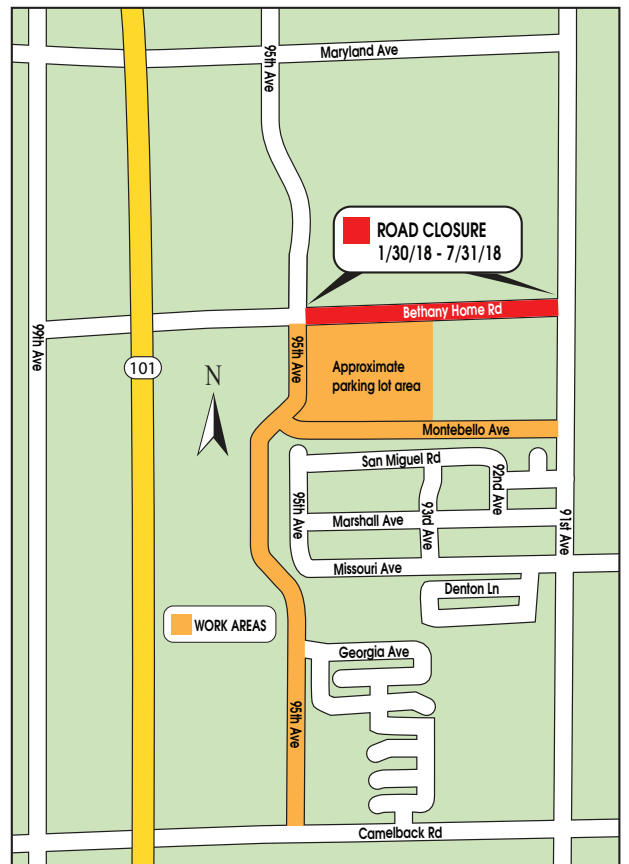
##### • Montebello Avenue: 95th Avenue to 91st Avenue

The contractor has completed the final layer of asphalt, landscaping, street lighting and sidewalk. Currently, crews are installing the equipment for the new traffic signal at 91st Avenue and Montebello Avenue.

##### • Pedestrian Infrastructure Improvements Project Bethany Home Road, 95th to 91st Avenues

Construction crews have installed the new asphalt. Now, the contractor is installing gates for the pedestrian underpass, bridge rails, sidewalk and the landscape irrigation system.

Enhancements include a pedestrian underpass and bridged crossing at the Grand Canal and the Bethany Home Outfall Channel and realignment of Bethany Home Road, among other improvements. **As a reminder, Bethany Home Road will remain closed between 95th and 91st avenues until July 31, 2018.**
